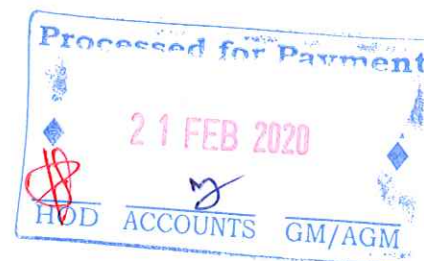

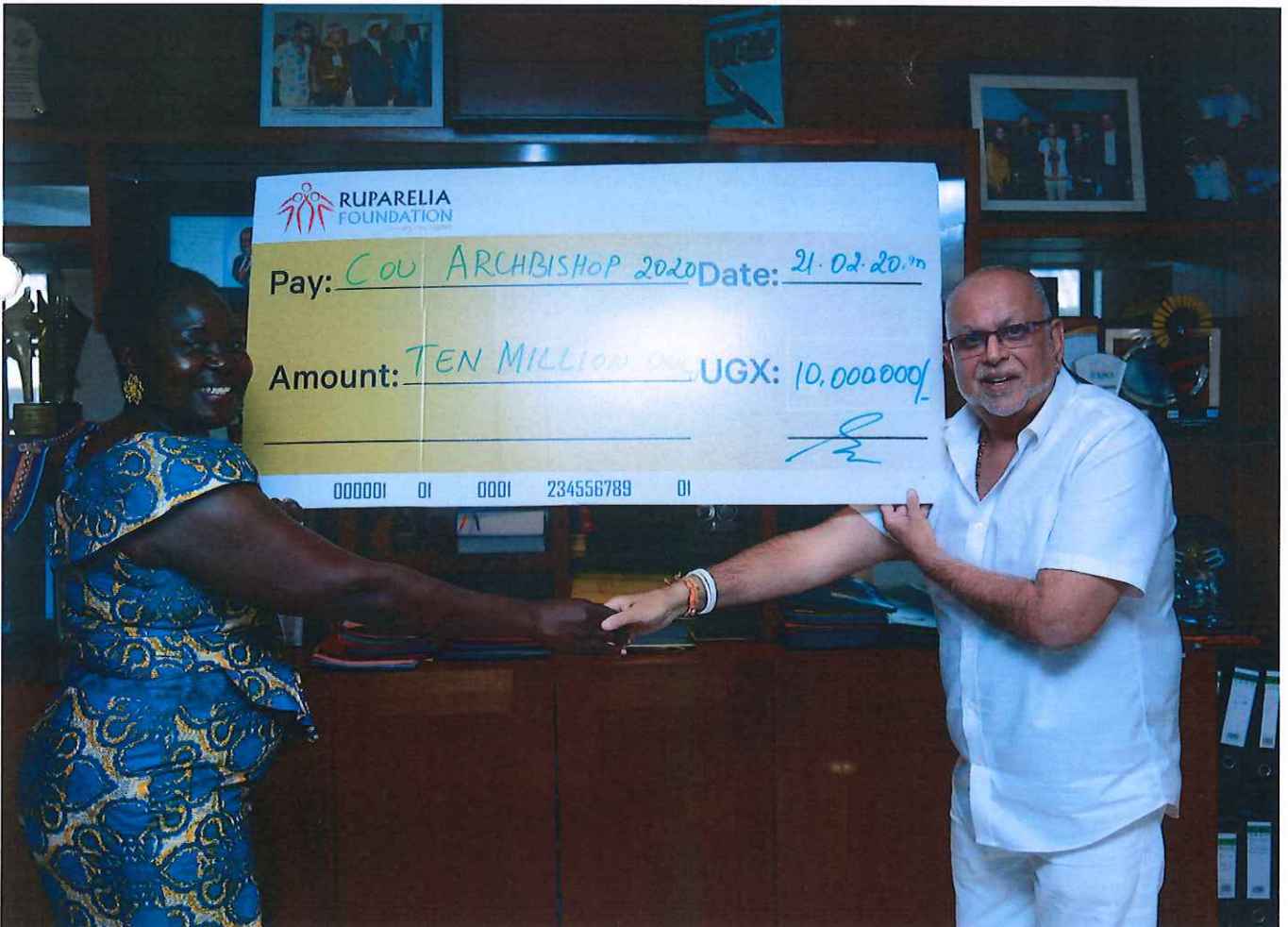

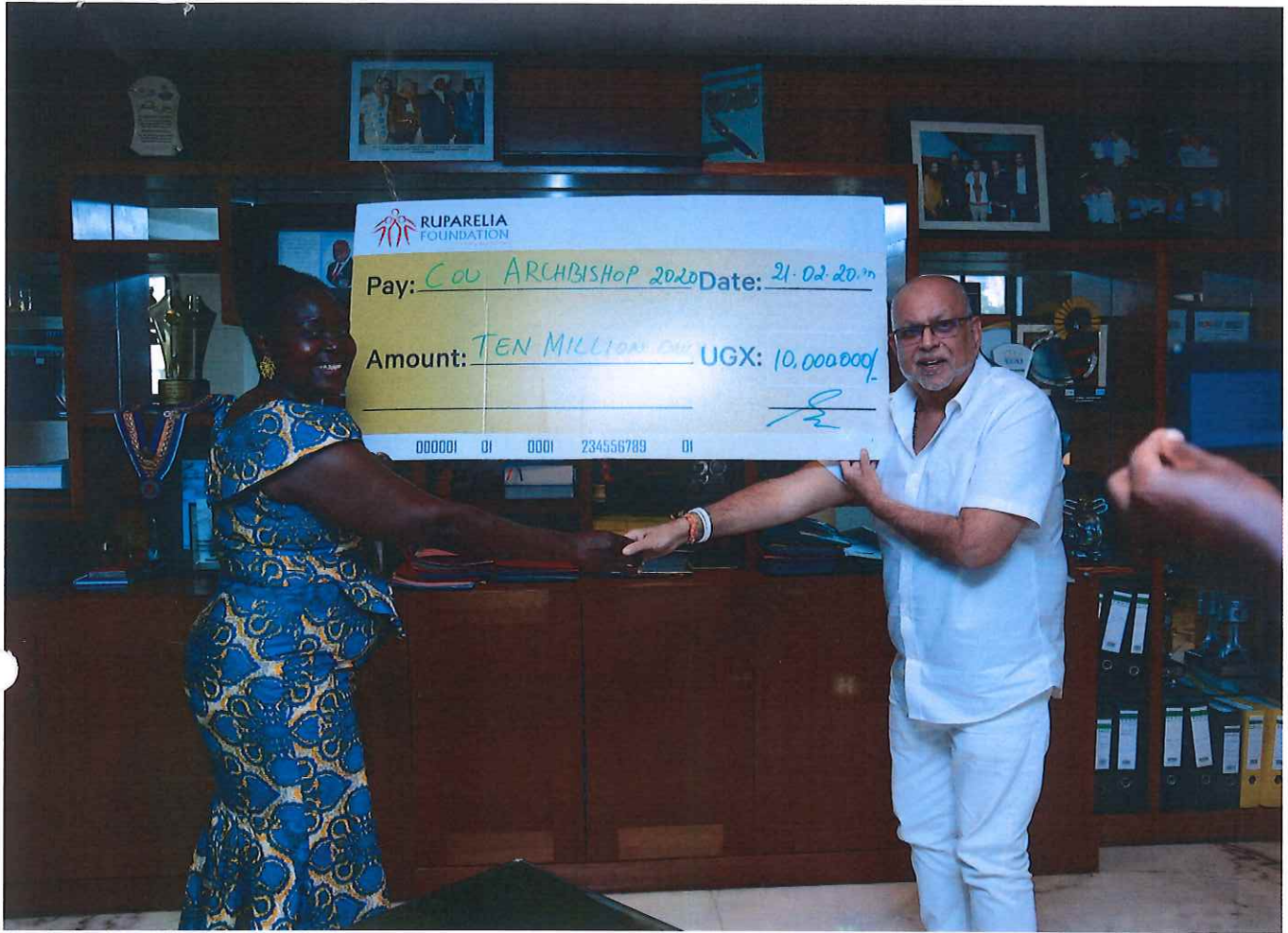

Review power agreements

The Government has admitted closing bad power purchase agreements with independent producers after spending billions of money on payments to energy sellers for electricity that Ugandans do not consume.

Finance state minister Gabriel Ajedra is quoted as saying some of the bad clauses include one requiring the government to pay energy sellers for unconsumed electricity.

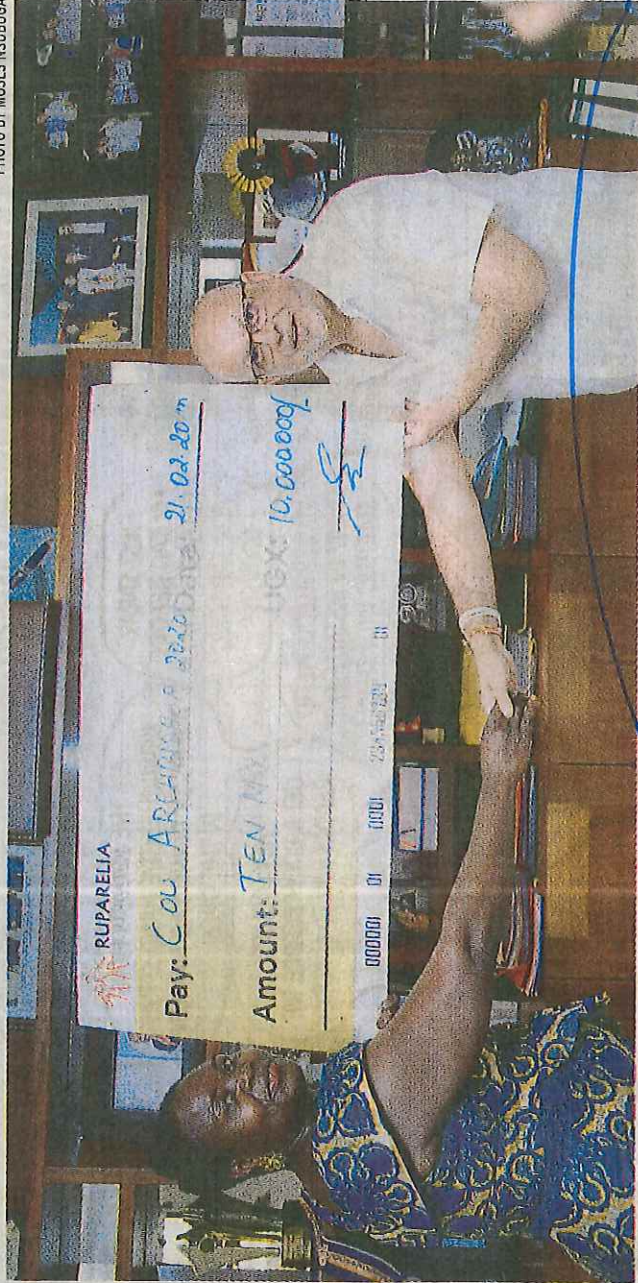
The power producers, under the existing agreements, are paid for all the energy generated at the plants running at full capacity. But a substantial amount of power generated is not consumed because of low demand due, in part, to limited electricity access - standing at 78% in urban areas and 58% in rural areas, according to the Electricity Regulatory Authority. In addition, the Government does not have a robust transmission infrastructure to evacuate all the power generated.
