1. Background

SFA came into existence on the 1st October 2015 with 11 swimmers who have since grown to 86 in ten months. The Academy went on to participate in the KSF National Age Group and Open Swimming Championships, 23 – 25 October 2015, in Mombasa; then in April 2016 in the CANA Zone 4 event held in Mauritius where Uganda was represented by 9 swimmers 4 of whom were from Silverfin Academy. The swimmers put up a good show with better times posted. SFA also participated in the Kenya Junior Championship held in May 2016 where our 14 swimmers put up an impressive show bagging 14 medals. SFA also participated in the USF Nationals and we came second overall. On the 6 of August 2016 we had a swimmer in the EGA winter gala No.3 in South Africa. On the 13-20 Feb 2017 we had a team of 4 swimmers representing Uganda in Bulawayo-Zimbabwe. On the 27-30 March 2017 we had a swimmer compete for the country in the Africa Junior Championships held in Egypt. In April 1-2, 2017 we took 28 swimmers to the Dolphins gala where we won 39 medals and came second overall making us the most efficient team. On 19-21 May 2017, a team of 26 junior swimmers participated in the Kenya Junior Championships and came 2nd overall out of 26 teams. This exceptional level of achievement is due to the talent and commitment of our members and the coaching team of the Academy.

The Academy has recruited five professional coaches, four of whom are FINA approved and certified. In its bid to grow and become the leading swimming academy in the region, Silverfin Academy has embarked on an ambitious plan to recruit and retain a proffessional swim Coach as the head coach - Ms. Rosa Rodriguez is a former international swimmer from the Philiphines with over 25 years coaching experience.

Our home training pool is the Kampala International School Uganda (KISU) swimming pool, and our training hours are from $4.30 \, \text{pm} - 7.30 \, \text{pm}$ Monday to Friday and holiday Camps which are from $7.00 \, \text{am} - 9.00 \, \text{am}$ Monday to Friday. SilverFin academy is working towards producing swimmers who will compete at a national, regional and international level, including the Olympics. We are confident that Uganda in general and Silverfin Academy in particular has excellent swimmers for whom this should not be difficult to achieve.

Our coaching team has already identified the club swimmers who are ready for competitions at a national and regional level, and they are currently training rigorously in preparation for the next upcoming regional meets which are:-

- 1. Kenya Swimming Championships in Mombasa (March 2018)
- 2. Uganda National Open Swimming Championships (May 2018)
- 3. Africa Senior Championships (November 2018)
- 4. CANA Zone 3 in Dar es Salaam (December 2018.)

2. Preamble

Silverfin Academy is a swimming club that is committed to nurturing and growing the sport of Swimming in Uganda, with a focus and commitment to giving the less priviledged swimmers an opportunity to receive professional training and a chance to compete competitively at national and international events. It is in this regard that we are kindly requesting **Ruparelia Foundation** to partner with us through a sponsorship aggreement which will be beneficial to both parties and most importantly the children who are our future.

The Academy kit worn by swimmers, coaches and parents includes T- shirts, swimming costumes, swimming bags, Swimming Caps, Track suits which will be worn both at competitions and Training. The club proposes to print the your logo on all items of their kit (where feasible) as well as providing a subsidised item of compulsory kit to be worn at all competitions. The Academy is one of the largest in the Country, with extremely talented swimmers of different ages and backgrounds, and this sponsorship is critical to our growth and success as well as ability to sponsor and support the less financially able, yet talented swimmers who could miss their calling in life. We are prepared to distribute promotional material throughout all the Events that we organise or attend throughout the year.

We are aware that word of mouth is by far the most powerful and trusted form of advertising. Through our extensive social media platforms and forums, we are in a strong position to advertise and give mileage to your brand at all the events .

A) Events

Silverfin Academy will be organising several events throughout the year, including an annual Invitational Swimming Gala, which should attract other participants from Zone III (covering East Africa), and Zone IV (which covers South Africa, Zambia, Botswana, Zimbabwe, Angola and Mauritius.) In addition to distributing promotional material at the event, a post-gala social event would provide excellent exposure for the organisation to promote its vision, and objectives. Alternatively, we could provide every competitor with a free event T-shirt, displaying your logo. Due to the lack of our own swimming pool, the club spends in excess of 40 million per year on pool hire costs which the club members must bear. With other costs such as kit and transport to International meets added in the cost of the club, membership fees become prohibitively high especially for our talented and yet less financially able swimmers who the club has to subsidise or in most instances fully sponsor.
