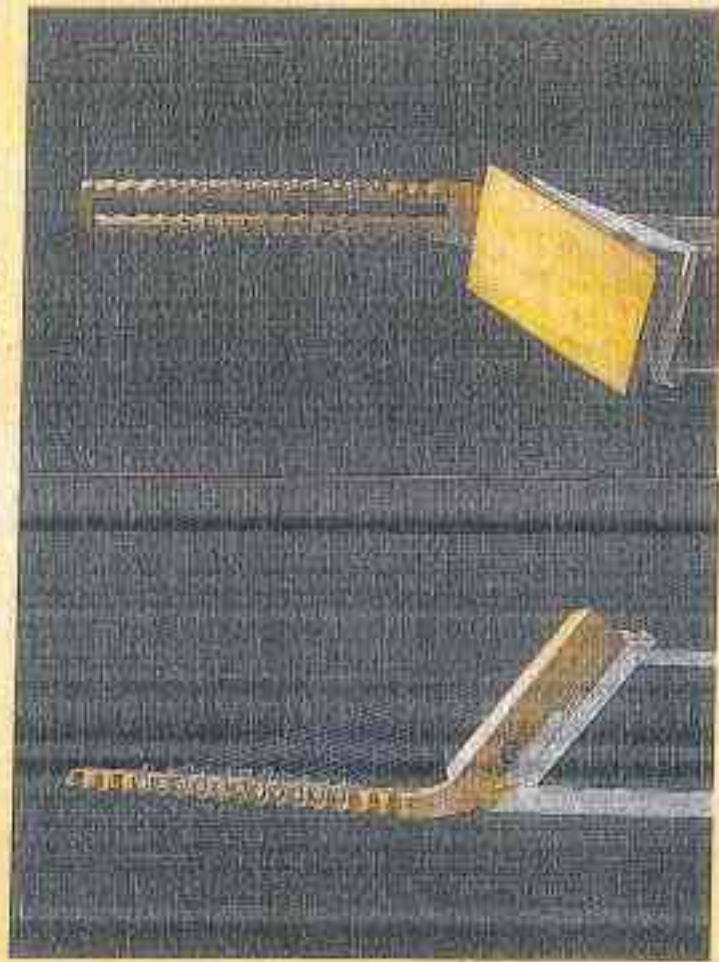

➤ Ssewa co-founded Janzi band in 2009 to extend his artistic mission with a collection of Uganda's most celebrated instrumentalists.

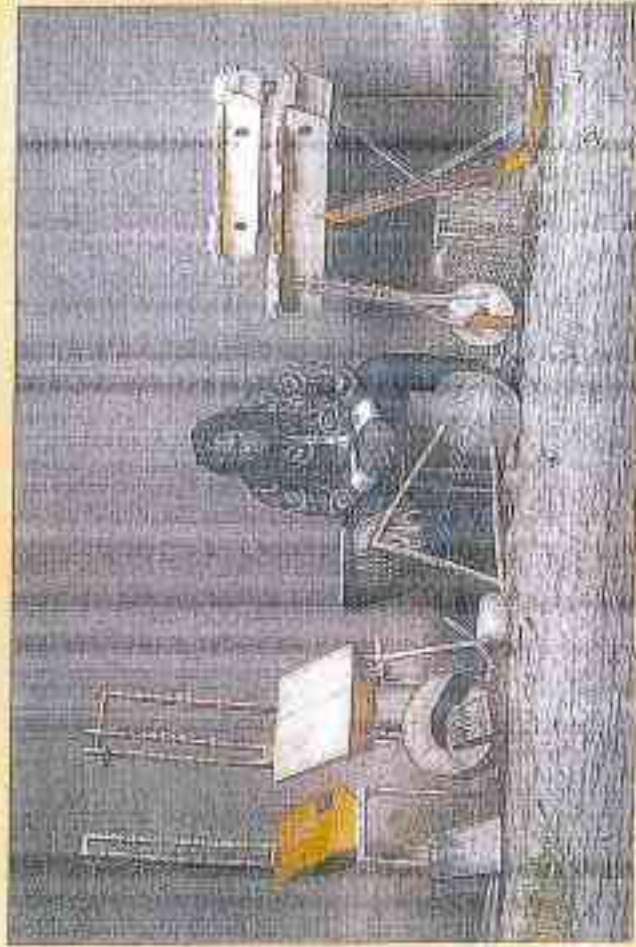

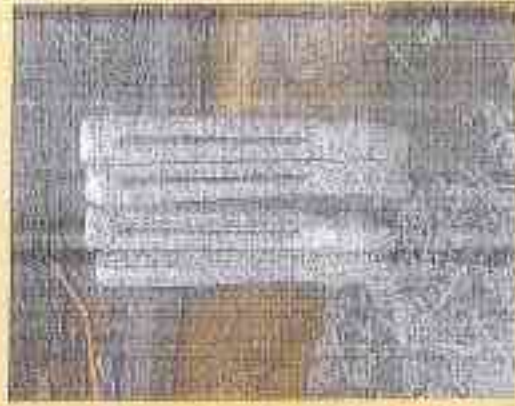
Other Innovations

- He has modified them with inbuilt pickups, and they look more modern than the traditional ones. He has videos of how they have looked like for centuries until now.

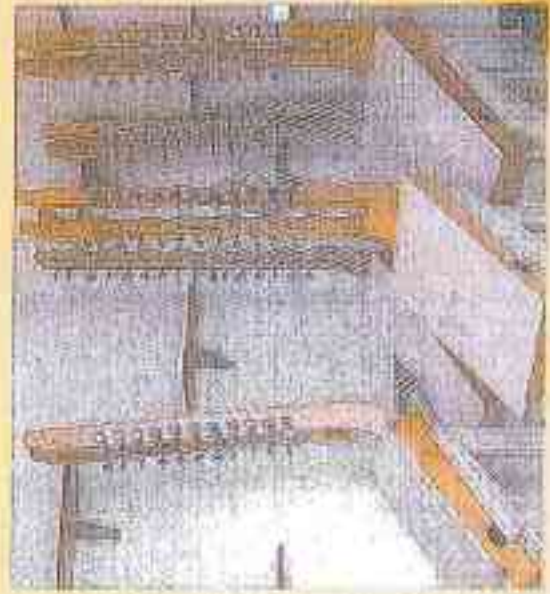


Making of Janzi


