

RE: FUNDING REQUEST

Reference is made to the historical relationship between Ngamba Island Chimpanzee Sanctuary and the Ruparelia Group through Mr. Sudhir Ruparelia, who has been of support to the welfare of the orphaned rescued chimpanzees at Ngamba Island through cash donation and in kind support. These supports were very valuable in getting Ngamba established and the operations in providing an excellent captive chimpanzees welfare in the sanctuary. To this, Ngamba Island Chimpanzee Sanctuary is rated as the "model wildlife sanctuary" in Africa and has received a number of accolades over the years. We appreciate your support to this achievement.

We currently are faced with a challenge of the lake water level that has risen higher than it has ever been with unusually very strong waves. Two weeks ago we had the camp area flooded and threatening the destruction of the facilities; the pier, the pathways, the staff housing, the visitor area and facilities. This is despite the effort we put in building a retainer wall in anticipation of this same problem. However, the amount of water and waves were more than we ever anticipated.

The chimpanzees of Ngamba Island urgently need you. We need to repair and undertake additional construction at the edge of the waters to stop further flooding and erosion of the land. We are waiting for the water level to stabilize before we can have a definite budget of what is required but already roughly we require about \$20,000 (Twenty thousand US dollars) to get started with the works on the pier, the retainer wall at the water edges, and the camp facilities, allowing essential care to continue to be given to rescued chimpanzees.

Your support towards the budget requirement is greatly appreciated. In return, we will provide recognition of your support in all our online communication platforms, a plaque with the full color logo of your Foundation will be placed at our "Corporate Supporters" wall at Ngamba and you will also receive a certificate.

I greatly thank you for your support in anticipation.
